OUR HISTORY ON THE SQUARE

Blythswood Square is a historic gem in the heart of Glasgow, steeped in architectural beauty and rich heritage. Once a loch known as Stobcross Dam, it was transformed in 1823 by Robert Black into an elegant Georgian retreat for the city's Victorian elite. With its grand townhouses and private gardens, it quickly became a symbol of wealth and sophistication.

Over time, urbanisation led many of these townhouses to become offices and commercial spaces, threatening the square's historic charm. However, in the 20th century, a revival began. One of the most significant landmarks was the Royal Scottish Automobile Club, established in 1901 in the very building that now houses Kimpton Blythswood Square. This exclusive club catered to high society, hosting glamorous automobile events that shaped the square's legacy.

Today, Blythswood Square thrives as a vibrant part of Glasgow's cultural and social scene, attracting visitors with its blend of history and modern luxury. Whether strolling through its serene gardens or exploring its grand architecture, the square stands as a testament to Glasgow's evolving story – where past elegance meets contemporary vibrancy.

We believe every wedding should be as unique as the couple saying "I do." Our 2026 wedding packages offer tailored options to suit your vision, style and requirements. Please see our current costs for 2026 below:

- Room Hire - £2,950.00
- Menu – from £75.00 per person
- Arrival Drink – from £10 per person
- Canapes – from £19.50 per person
- Half bottle of house wine – from £18.00 per person
- Toast drink – from £10 per person
- Buffet – from £29.50 per person
- 6 bedrooms above the Monte Carlo Suite – From £2,800 (you are required to book these bedrooms if you wish to have your evening reception at the hotel)

FAQS

What is the maximum number of guests we can invite?

We can cater to a maximum of 64 guests for the ceremony, and a total of 80 guests for the meal and evening reception. Though, of course, we can design and tailor a bespoke wedding package to suit your preferences.

Can we have access to Blythwood Square Gardens?

We can provide access to our beautiful gardens for photographs, however we can't guarantee exclusive usage as the gardens do, on occasion, rent out to other clients and we share them with our neighbours on the square. Kimpton Blythwood Square doesn't own the gardens ourselves, we simply pay a fee for you to use the gardens which is included in your room hire fee.

What's the payment plan? What forms of payment do you accept?

We require a £1000 deposit along with your signed contract to secure your wedding date. From there, a further payment of 50% is due 3 months prior to the wedding date and the balance due 14 days prior to the wedding itself. Payments can be made via BACS, card payments over the phone or in person.

Can I have my ceremony here, too? Is there an additional cost?

You are very welcome to have your ceremony here at Kimpton Blythwood Square and there is no extra fee to do so if you're booking the venue for your wedding meal.

Do you allow external catering?

Sadly, due to the layout of the kitchens within the hotel we can't accommodate external caterers.

Are tables, linens, chairs, plates, silverware, and glassware provided, or will I have to organise them myself?

Our herringbone wooden tables, sea green and walnut wood chairs, silver cutlery, clear glassware, white crockery and white linen napkins are all included within your costs. Should you wish chiavari chairs, tablecloths, different cutlery/crockery or table centre pieces/décor for the space, you would organise this with an external supplier. We have a list of recommended suppliers to assist you.

Can the venue accommodate a DJ or live band?

Of course, however, if you wish to host your evening reception at the hotel with a DJ or live band you would be required to reserve the 6 bedrooms above the Monte Carlo Suite for your wedding night. Please speak with your coordinator for bedrooms rates for your chosen wedding date.

What time can my vendors start setting up on the day of the wedding?

We welcome supplier access from 7am on the morning of the wedding to set up.

Do you have a sound system and/or microphones for speeches?

The Monte Carlo Suite doesn't have a built in microphone for speeches, although we can hire a 4 speaker PA system and handheld microphone from our AV company. Please speak with your coordinator for pricing.

Is there parking on site and if so, is it complimentary? If not, where will my guests park?

Unfortunately, we don't have onsite parking at the hotel, guests can park in Q-Park on Sauchiehall Street for 24 hours for £20, or if you would like Valet Parking this costs £35 per 24 hours.

What overnight accommodations do you provide?

We have 113 bedrooms at the hotel, and we can provide a discount link (50 weeks prior to your wedding date) for guests to receive a 10% discount on our best available rate at the time of booking, including breakfast.

What time would you recommend we hold our wedding ceremony?

We usually suggest the following timings for your wedding day, however these can be amended to your preference by speaking to your coordinator.

1.30pm – Ceremony
2pm – Drinks Reception
3.30pm – Guests seated
3.45pm – Couple seated
4pm – Speeches
4.30pm – Wedding Meal
6.30pm – Turnaround for evening reception
7.30pm – Evening Guests arrive
8pm – Evening Reception
9.30pm – Evening Buffet served
Midnight – Event ends

Do we get a menu tasting for our wedding?

We will invite you for a complimentary menu tasting approximately 3 months prior to the wedding date so you can sample the food for your big day.

Can we bring our furry friend to enjoy our wedding day?

You are very welcome to have your paw-pal walk you down the aisle and celebrate your big day with you! Kimpton Blythwood Square is pet friendly. Our rule is if they fit in the lift, they're welcome to stay.
