HISTORIC BOSTON – DAY 2

HARBORWALK

Enjoy the sunrise and walk or run along the Harborwalk, the near-continuous, 43-mile linear park along Boston's shoreline. The Harborwalk connects Boston's waterfront neighborhoods to Boston Harbor and each other.

FENWAY PARK TOUR

Travel back to 1912 and enjoy a guided tour of Fenway Park and take in the magnificent view of the field atop the 37' 2" high Green Monster, overlooking where Ted Williams, Yaz, Big Papi and Jim Rice once played.*

FREEDOM TRAIL

Spend the afternoon meandering along the 2 ½ mile long Freedom Trail walking tour of 16 historic sites from the Colonial and Revolutionary Era. A red brick trail connects each of the sites.
