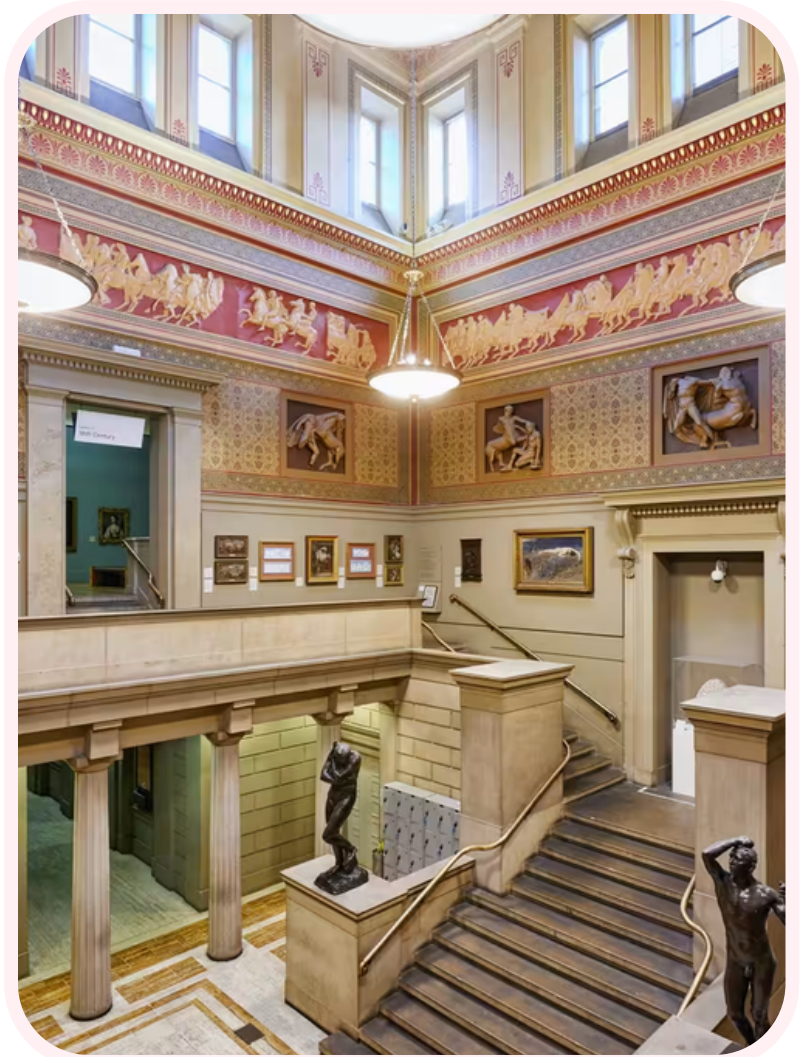

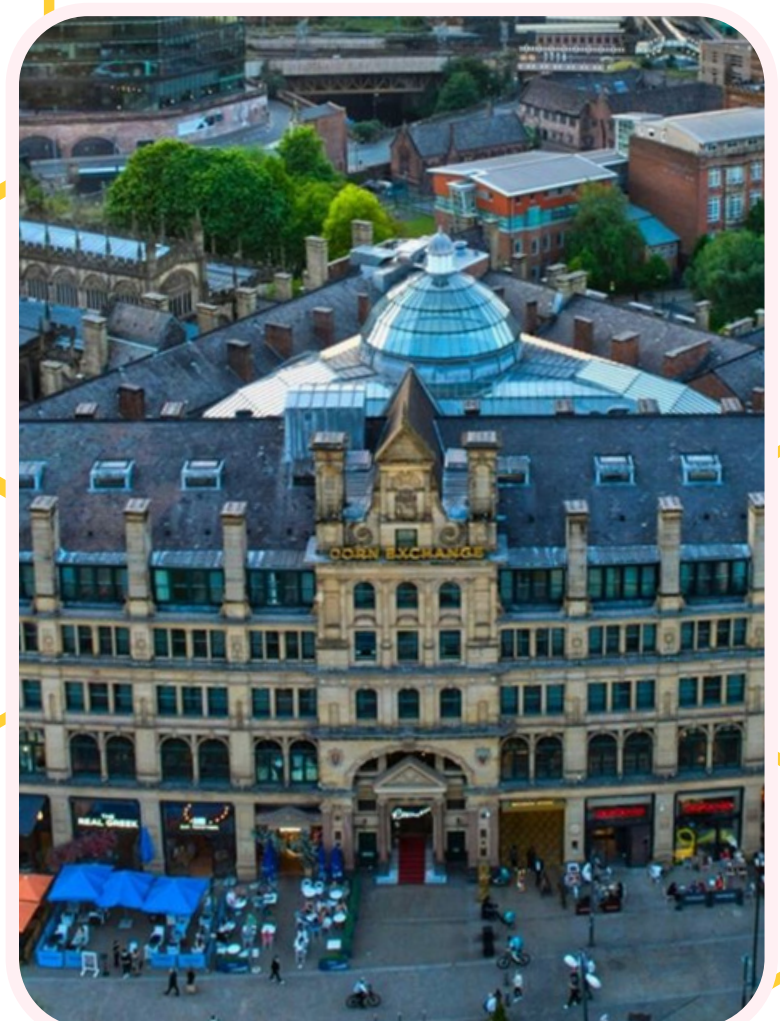
Lunch at Exchange Square

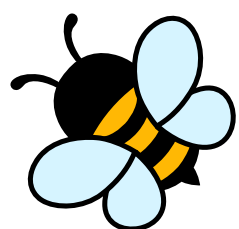

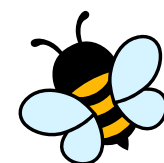
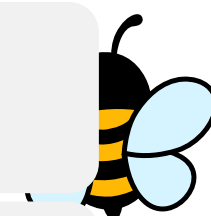
St Peter's Square

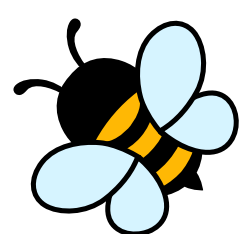
Dinner & Drinks at Ramona

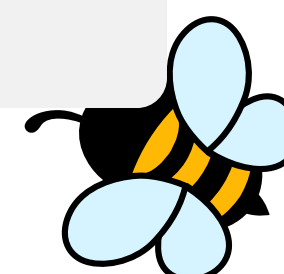
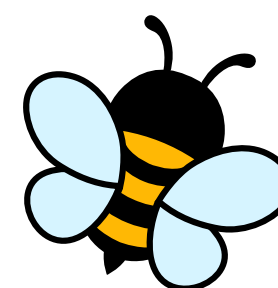
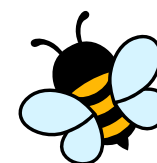
Party the Night Away



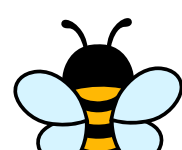
Northern Quarter – right behind the hotel
