We are Green Key Gold certified. The Green Key certificate is the leading standard for sustainable operation within the tourism industry.

Energy, water and CO2 emissions



- o All light bulbs are energy-efficient LEDs, which helps reduce our overall energy consumption.
- Our showerheads use a maximum of 9 liters per minute to reduce water consumption, without compromising on guest comfort.
- We have solar panels and a contract for electricity sourced from European wind and solar energy.
- Via geothermal heat, we use heat that is stored in the ground to warm our building.

Waste



- Shampoo and shower gel products are presented in dispensers instead of small packages to reduce plastic waste.
- Waste is collected for recycling such as coffee residue, paper, cardboard, glass, plastic, bottles with refund, organic/food waste and cooking oil.
- We aim to work with the principle 'reduce, reuse, recycle'.
- For breakfast, we have a buffet offering everything you would like for a good start of the day. We focus on minimizing packaged products where possible.

Products and routines



- Many paper products have an ecolabel, such as toilet- or printing paper and tissues.
- Our daily cleaning products used by housekeeping have an officially recognized ecolabel, meaning that the product meets strict environmental standards.
- We optimize housekeeping services by not changing bedlinen daily, but earlier on request or when necessary. Please use the 'Enjoy a Greener Stay' card. You can choose to re-use your towels as well.
- We always offer several vegetarian dishes.
- We support biodiversity with an insect hotel and we have a green roof.

Social responsibility and commitment



- We have a 'Green Team' with colleagues from several departments.
- o Every employee receives sustainability training.
- We support good causes and organize 'IHG Giving for Good Months' each September.
