Beside shopping in Causeway Bay, it may be time to visit the Canal Road Flyover also known as Ngo Keng Kiu literally meaning “Goose-Neck-Bridge”. There you can witness the local ritual of beating a paper doll with a shoe known as “Villain Hitting”.

Villain hitting is a customary practice in Cantonese culture, it was originally done to ward off evil spirits. However, nowadays it is more commonly used to curse one's enemies or to dispel bad luck; involving the use of a shoe to strike a photo or a piece of paper with the name written on it. If you haven't witnessed a villain hitting, you haven't truly immersed yourself in Causeway Bay. Go and check it out.
