CHAMPAGNE

The Champagne wine region (archaic English: Champany) is a historic province within the Champagne administrative province in the northeast of France. The area is best known for the production of the sparkling white wine that bears the regions name. EU law and the laws of most countries reserve the term «Champagne» exclusively for wines that come from this region located about 100 miles (160 km) east of Paris. The viticulture boundaries of Champagne are legally defined and split into five wine producing districts within the administrative province: Aube, Côte des Blancs, Côte de Sézanne, Montagne de Reims, and Valley de la Marne. The towns of Reims and Épernay are the commercial centers of the area.



GERMANY

Among enthusiasts, Germany's reputation is primarily based on wines made from the Riesling grape variety, which at its best is used for aromatic, fruity, and elegant white wines that range from very crisp and dry to well-balanced, sweet and enormous aromatic concentration. The proportion of German vineyards devoted to the cultivation of dark-skinned grape varieties has now stabilized at slightly more than a third of the total surface. For the red wines, Spatburgunder, the domestic name for Pinot noir, is in the lead.


