

WELCOME TO KIMPTON CLOCKTOWER

Hints of greenery, wafting music, and a Mancunian welcome from the hotel team hint at what's to come: an approachable destination that's never stuffy—one that fuses sumptuous details, like the lobby's beautiful glass dome and signature bronze horse sculpture, with raw, real artisan touches.



At Kimpton Clocktower our fully restored spaces promise to fulfil your every dream – after all, your big day should be as extraordinary as you are.






THE DIRECTORS' ROOM WOOD-PANELLED OPULENCE

Built in 1912 as part of Paul Waterhouse's extension to the original Refuge Assurance Building, The Directors' Rooms remain the grandest rooms in the whole of the hotel, brimming with architectural detail and craftsmanship, certain to create a lasting impression.

With its over-sized windows and stunning oak panelling, The Directors' Rooms appeal to those guests looking for a luxury feel to their wedding day for up to 60 guests. The journey begins with the ornate marble staircase, with the suite licensed for your civil ceremony and perfect for an exceptional dining experience.






THE BALLROOM & THE WHITWORTH A SENSE OF OCCASION, ON A GRAND SCALE




